Chemistry	Questions from: a) Chemistry — 39 questions b) Mathematics — 6 questions c) Physics and Biology — 5 questions	Class XI–XII level Chemistry, Mathematics, Physics and Biology across all major boards of education (e.g. ISC, CBSE, WBCHSE)
Statistics	50 Questions from Mathematics	Class XI–XII level Mathematics across all major boards of education (e.g. ISC, CBSE, WBCHSE)
Life Sciences	50 Questions from Biology, Physics and Chemistry	Class XI–XII level Biology, Physics and Chemistry across all major boards of education (e.g. ISC, CBSE, WBCHSE)
Economics	Questions from: a) Mathematics — 35 questions b) English — 15 questions (Grammar, Vocabulary, analytical language skills)	Class XI–XII level Mathematics and English across all major boards of education (e.g. ISC, CBSE, WBCHSE)
Political Science	Questions from: a) General knowledge of politics and society — 15 questions b) English Comprehension — 15 questions c) Logical Reasoning — 15 questions d) Picture / visual analysis — 5 questions	Class XI–XII level English and General aptitude across all major boards of education (e.g. ISC, CBSE, WBCHSE, WBBME)
