

TS EdCET 2026 Expected Cutoff

Telangana State Education Common Entrance Test — B.Ed. Admissions

There is no fixed cutoff applicable to all colleges. Admission depends on multiple factors, including the candidate's rank and the number of available seats.

Minimum Qualifying Cutoff Marks (Category-wise)

Category	Qualifying Percentage	Marks Required (out of 150)
OC / General	25%	38
BC (A, B, C, D, E)	25%	38
EWS	25%	38
SC	No minimum	Not specified
ST	No minimum	Not specified

SC/ST candidates must secure at least 25% marks only if applying under NCC / Sports & Games / Physically Handicapped / Children of Armed Personnel (CAP) quota seats.

The Cutoff May Vary Due To

- Number of applicants
- Difficulty level of the examination
- Number of qualified candidates
- Reservation policy
- College preference
- Seat availability

Factors Affecting TS EdCET Cutoff

- Overall exam difficulty
- Candidate performance
- Total seats available
- Number of counselling participants
- Category-wise reservation
- Previous year's admission trends

TS EdCET 2026 Expected Cutoff Range (Rank-wise)

Although the closing rank differs across colleges, the table below gives a general idea of admission chances based on rank range.

Rank Range	Admission Chances
1 – 500	Excellent chances in top government and university colleges
501 – 2,000	Good chances in reputed government and private colleges
2,001 – 5,000	Good chances in many recognised colleges
5,001 – 10,000	Admission possible in several private colleges
10,001 – 20,000	Admission possible in private colleges with seats available after earlier rounds
Above 20,000	Admission depends heavily on seat availability and later counselling rounds

The above ranges are indicative and may change every year depending on exam turnout, seat matrix, and reservation norms.
