

Know All About 4 Symbiosis Law Schools

Admission via SLAT • Check Seats • Fees in INR (Rs.) • Courses

1. Overview

Symbiosis International (Deemed University) operates four Symbiosis Law Schools (SLS) across India — SLS Pune, SLS Noida, SLS Hyderabad, and SLS Nagpur. Admission to the flagship 5-year integrated BA LLB and BBA LLB programmes at all four campuses is granted through the Symbiosis Law Admission Test (SLAT), followed by a Personal Interaction (PI) round. Admission to the LLM programme is based on the All India Admission Test (AIAT), while the 3-year LLB programme (offered only at SLS Pune) admits students through the Symbiosis Law School All India Admission Test.

SLS Pune is the flagship campus and is consistently ranked among the top law colleges in India (NIRF and other national rankings place it among the top 10 private law schools).

2. The Four Symbiosis Law School Campuses

3. Admission Process

- **BA LLB / BBA LLB (5-year, all 4 campuses):** Admission via SLAT score, followed by Personal Interaction (PI). Weightage is typically SLAT score (70%) and PI (30%).
- **3-year LLB (SLS Pune only):** Admission via the Symbiosis Law School All India Admission Test (AIAT), conducted in Centre-Based Test (CBT) mode.
- **LLM (1-year, all campuses):** Admission based on the All India Admission Test (AIAT).
- **Eligibility (UG programmes):** Candidates must have passed 10+2 with at least 45% aggregate marks (40% for SC/ST candidates) from a recognised board.
- **SLAT Registration Fee:** Approx. Rs. 2,250; separate SLS programme registration fee of approx. Rs. 1,000 per programme.

7. Key Highlights

- All four SLS campuses are approved by the Bar Council of India (BCI) and accredited by NAAC.
- SLS Pune is the flagship campus, ranked among the top private law colleges in India, with strong placement records (average packages around Rs. 13 LPA in recent years).
- SLAT tests reading ability, logical reasoning, legal aptitude, and analytical skills.
- Only SLS Noida serves North India among the four campuses; SLS Pune, Hyderabad, and Nagpur are in Western/Southern India.
- A good SLAT score is generally considered 45+ marks; for SLS Pune (most competitive), aspirants often target 48-52 marks.

8. Quick FAQs

Q: Can I get into any of the 4 SLS campuses with one SLAT score?

Yes. A single SLAT score is valid for admission consideration across SLS Pune, Noida, Hyderabad, and Nagpur.

Q: Which courses use SLAT vs AIAT for admission?

BA LLB and BBA LLB (5-year) use SLAT + PI. The 3-year LLB (Pune only) and LLM (all campuses) use AIAT.

Q: Are fees the same across all 4 campuses?

No. Each SLS campus has its own independent fee structure, which should be verified on the official website or Shiksha.com before applying.
